

24, 1973. Since it was declared not to have been prepared in conformity with the "public hearings" requirement, the Court of Appeals invalidated it on July 31, 1973. The Court of Appeals then established new boundaries for the forty-seven legislative districts by an order dated March 15, 1974 (Misc. Nos. 5 and 6, September Term 1972, and Misc. Nos. 1-4, 7-13, September Term, 1973). The boundaries are as follows:
