Origin and Name of the County:

Named for John Eager Howard, soldier and statesman. The County was created in 1851 by Article VIII, Section 1 of the Constitution of that year. However, the area which later became Howard County was set up as Howard District of Anne Arundel County by Chapter 22 of the Acts of 1838; confirmed by Chapter 50, Acts of 1839 and thereafter, until 1851, enjoyed the status of a county except that it was not represented in the General Assembly.

¹⁰⁸ Consists of 5 persons appointed by the former Board of County Commissioners for 5-year terms. The Board is composed of 3 Master Electricians, an architect and an engineer (Ch. 754, Acts of 1968).

¹⁰⁹ Appointed by the Liquor Control Board.

¹¹⁰ Composed of 9 members, of whom the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, the President of the Harford Community College and the Chairman of the Board of Education for Harford County serve ex officio. The 6 remaining directors are appointed by the County Commissioners for the initial terms. As these expire, the directors will be elected by a majority vote of the Foundation for 3-year terms (Ch. 493, Acts of 1969).
