Chapter 745 - 1973

AN ACT imposing requirements for a balanced budget, rethe budget bill as submitted by the Governor, supplemented by the Governor and amended by the General Assembly contain proposed appropriations not in excess of total estimated revenues.

Chapter 879 - 1974

AN ACT providing for the suspension, without pay or benefits, of certain elected officials from office upon conviction of or the entry of certain pleas to certain crimes and for the removal of such officials if the conviction becomes final; providing for appointments to fill such elective office during such suspension; providing for the reinstatement of such elected official and the restoration of pay and benefits under certain circumstances.
