The Governor's Executive Council originated as the Governor's Advisory Council in 1922 (Chapter 29, Acts of 1922). It was reorganized in 1969 as the Governor's Executive Council to coordinate, direct, and supervise State government (Chapter 156, Acts of 1969). The Council consists of the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the Secretary of State, the secretary of each principal department of the Executive Branch of State government, the State Superintendent of Schools, the Secretary of Higher Education, the Director on Aging, and the Director of Planning. The Governor may appoint an Executive Secretary for the Council (Code State Government Article, secs. 8-101, 8-105).
