The Governor established the Task Force on the Charles H. Hickey, Jr. School in February 1991. The Task Force examined the recreational and training programs, treatment plans and practices, and management structure of the School and made recommendations on its future. Located in Baltimore County, the Hickey School is a detention and training facility for juveniles sentenced or awaiting sentence by the courts.

The Task Force's sixteen members were appointed by the Governor. The Task Force reported its findings and recommendations to the Governor and General Assembly in May 1991.

The Governor created the Task Force on Front Foot Assessment on Farmland in November 1989 at the request of the General Assembly (Joint Resolution no. 18, Acts of 1989).

The Task Force reviewed policies of counties, municipalities, and special taxing districts with respect to the construction and financing of water, sewerage, and refuse disposal services and the imposition of a front foot assessment on farmland. The Task Force evaluated the impact of those policies on keeping farmland in agricultural production.

The Task Force submitted a final report to the Governor and General Assembly in July 1990.
