Semi-annual Reports to Governor & chairpersons of appropriate legislative committees.

The Governor created the State Data Security Committee in 1983 (Executive Order 01.01.1983.18). The Committee establishes computer security policies and standards for State government agencies in the Executive Branch. The Committee regularly evaluates and tests the security of computerized records systems of State agencies.

The Committee consists of nine data professionals within State service. One member is appointed from each of the following agencies: Comptroller of the Treasury; Department of Budget and Fiscal Planning (whose representative serves as chairperson); Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services; Department of Transportation; and University of Maryland System. Four members are appointed by the Governor upon recommendation of the chairperson. Any agency security officer assigned to the Committee may not participate in any computer system security analysis of that officer's own agency by the Committee.
