

Under the the head of "Miscellaneous Appropriations," line 1, strike out the word "watchmen," and insert the word: watchman.

Line 2, strike out the words "each twelve hundred dollars."

Line 11, strike out the words "one hundred," and insert in lieu thereof: fifty.

Amend line 11 by inserting after the word "dollars," for repairing the roof of the State House, five hundred dollars to be expended under the direction of Augustus Gassaway, Secretary of the Senate.

Line 28, after the word "contract," insert the words: in writing.
