

Add at end of section 2, chapter 20, and the several Colleges and Academies shall respectively receive the donations granted to them by any laws or resolutions of the General Assembly, subject to the conditions annexed thereto.

Chapter 18, "High Schools"—Section 1, it shall be the duty of the Board of County School Commissioners when any election district or any contiguous election districts shall present a building for a High School in said district or districts to the Board of County School Commissioners, to accept the same, (if in the judgment of the Board there is any necessity therefor,) and thereafter provide for maintenance of a High School in said district or districts, and the salary of teachers out of the general school fund.

Sections 2, 3 and 4, of printed bill, retained.

Amend page 14, chapter 6, section 3, line 2, by striking out "District," and inserting: county.

Printed bill, page 13, chapter 6, section 1, strike out all after the word "duty," in the first line to the word "the," in the second line.

Page 13, chapter 5, printed bill, section 3, line 3, strike out "District," and insert: county.
