Mr. Timmons, from the Select Committee to whom was referred House bill entitled an Act to regulate fees of the Sheriff of Worcester county, so far as relates to board of prisoners, reported it without amendment.

Mr. Henry, from the Select Committee to whom the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled an Act for the relief of the Cambridge Harbor Internal Navigation and Wharf Company.

Mr. Malone, from the Select Committee to whom the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled an Act to amend the 10th section of the Act of 1868, chapter 299, relating to public roads, so as to exclude Wicomico county therein, and to make all the provisions of the said Act apply to Wicomico county, so as to read as follows.
