Mr. Earle, from the Committee on Finance, to whom was referred House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 4, of chapter 466, of 1868, entitled an Act to run, define and mark the dividing line between Prince George's and Montgomery counties, and re-enact the same so as to read as follows, reported it without amendment.

Said bill was then read the second time.

Mr. Earle, from the Select Committee, to whom the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled an Act to repeal section 108 of chapter 161, of the Acts of 1865, relating to gates on the public roads in Queen Anne's county.
