

The House bill entitled an Act to regulate and make uniform the compensation of the Judges of the Orphans' Courts of the several counties, and to fix the compensation of the Judges of the Orphans' Court of Baltimore city, in pursuance of the 40th section of the 41st Article of the Constitution;

Was considered and postponed until Monday, the 4th instant.
