

Commissioners of said County; one half for the use of the Public Schools in said County, and one half for the benefit of the informer, said fine to be recovered before a Justice of the Peace of said County.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 13.

AN ACT to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the gift and bequest of Andrew Small, late of Washington City, deceased, to the Board of Trustees of the Neelsville and Darnstown Presbyterian Church, of "Montgomery County, Maryland," and to a sale of lands made by Richard M. Williams, trustee to said Board of Trustees:

WHEREAS, Andrew Small, late of Washington City, deceased, did, during his lifetime, donate the sum of five thousand dollars, and by his last will and testament, duly admitted to probate, and recorded in the office of Register of Wills for Washington County, in the District of Columbia, bequeath the sum of thirty-five thousand dollars to the Board of Trustees of the Neelsville and Darnstown Presbyterian Church, of Montgomery County, Maryland, and their successors; and whereas, Richard M. Williams, as trustee, appointed by the Circuit Court for Montgomery County, did, by deed bearing date the nineteenth day of September, in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-five, convey unto the said Board of Trustees of the Neelsville and Darnstown Presbyterian Church of Montgomery County, Maryland, twelve and one-half acres of land, more or less; therefore,
