Sec. 6. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 399.

AN ACT to Release the Sureties on the official bond of J. B. Price, Sheriff of Cecil County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That B. B. Price, Joseph Megill, W. H. Emerson, Francis King, Ebenezer Clark, Josias Blackway and Benjamin Miller, sureties on the official bond of James B. Price, Sheriff for Cecil County, for the years eighteen hundred and sixty-four and eighteen hundred and sixty-five, be and they are hereby released from the payment of interest on all sums due the State from the said J. B. Price; *provided*, that on or before the first day of October, eighteen hundred and seventy, the sureties pay into the Treasury the amount of the principal sum due the State as ascertained by the Comptroller of the Treasury. Release securities.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.
