

JOINT RESOLUTIONS

*Assented to by the General Assembly of Maryland, at a Session
begun on the 5th day of January, 1870, and ended
on the 4th day of April, 1870.*

No. 1.

To remit Colonization Tax levied under Chapter two hundred and eighty-one of eighteen hundred and thirty-one.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sums standing on the books of the Treasury against the several counties of this State, levied for Colonization purposes, under Chapter two hundred and eighty-one of eighteen hundred and thirty-one, be and the same are hereby remitted, and that all such accounts be stricken from the books of the Department.
