An act to repeal section three of chapter two hundred and forty-six, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled "An act to aid in the establishment of a Hospital in connection with the Washington University of Baltimore, and to appropriate money for the same," and to re-enact the same to read as follows..... 18
