A bill entitled an Act for the protection of Fish and Terrapins in the tributaries of the Potomac river, lying in St. Mary's county, and to regulate the time and manner of catching and taking Fish in that portion of the Potomac river between Cobb Point, in Charles county, and Point Lookout, in St. Mary's county,

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays with proposed amendment."
