

CHAPTER 273.

AN ACT to refund to Trueman, Belt & Sons, of Baltimore city, for the benefit of William D. Bowie, Sr., Clement Hill, Mordecai S. Plummer, Washington G. Beall, and others, moneys erroneously paid by them to Inspectors of Tobacco in Baltimore city, for outage and storage.

Comptroller authorized to issue his warrant to refund to Trueman, Belt & Sons, for sundry persons, moneys erroneously paid to Inspectors of Tobacco.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer in favor of Trueman, Belt and Sons, for the benefit of the following persons, to wit: for William D.
