Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to repeal section 14, of the Act passed April 4th, 1870, entitled an Act to incorporate the Baltimore and Hall's Springs Railway Company, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill, entitled an Act to repeal section 101, of Article XXVIII., of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to draining lands, and to re-enact the same with amendments.
