The following Acts having passed both branches of the General Assembly of Maryland, were this day presented to his Excellency, the Governor, for his approval:

An Act to authorize Marcellus W. J. Larmore to settle his final accounts as guardian to Ambrose H. D. Larmore, and to pay over all money due said ward.

Also,

An Act to renew and amend an Act, entitled an Act to incorporate the Baltimore Manual Labor School for Indigent Boys, passed March 14th, 1850, being chapter 247, of the Act of 1869.

Also,

An Act to amend chapter 126, of the Laws passed January Session, 1870, entitled an Act to authorize the Faculty and Board of Trustees of the Washington University of Baltimore, to use the real estate of said University, situated at the corner of Calvert and Saratoga streets, in Baltimore City, as a basis of credit to raise a sum of money not exceeding ten thousand dollars, by creating a ground rent thereon for the uses of said University.

Also,

An Act to exempt Caroline and Kent counties from the operation of chapter 231, of the Public Local Laws, entitled an Act to protect fish and wild fowl in the waters of Queen Anne's, Kent, Caroline and Harford counties, passed January Session, 1870.

Also,

An Act authorizing Dr. William Stewart, guardian of John Walter, a minor, to pass his final account with the Orphans' Court of Somerset county.

Also,

An Act to authorize Louisa M. Rial to settle her account as guardian to Albert Rial, and deliver over the estate to said ward.

Also,

An Act for the relief of the sureties on the bonds of Stephen R. Gore, late Collector of county taxes in Carroll county.
