Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations, to introduce a bill to incorporate a Water Company for Hagerstown, Washington county.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations, to introduce a bill to amend the charter of the Washington University, so as to increase the number of Professors therein.

On motion of Mr. Linthicum,

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary, to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal section 138, of Article XVI. of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Chancery," sub-title "Trustees," and to re-enact the same with amendment.

Leave was granted to the Anne Arundel delegation, to introduce a bill to authorize the Commissioners of Anne Arundel county to appropriate a sum of money to the capital stock of the Annapolis and South Severn Bridge Company.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Ways and Means, to introduce a bill entitled an Act to relieve Daniel Michael, Collector of Frederick county, for the years 1858 and 1859, for interest charged and chargeable to said Collector.
