Mealy, of Washington county, deceased, the sum of four hundred and forty-two dollars and seventy cents, the amount of a bail bond, interest and costs forfeited to the State by Edward M. Mealy, of Washington county, deceased, as surety for Lee Albaugh.

A bill, entitled an Act to refund to Freeman Belt & Sons, of Baltimore City, for the benefit of William D. Bowie, Sr., Clement Hill, Mordecai S. Plummer, Washington G. Beall, and others, moneys erroneously paid by them to Inspectors of Tobacco, in Baltimore City, for outage,
