

Amend section 2, by striking out all of said section, and substituting the following in lieu thereof.

Section 2. *And be it enacted*, That the County Treasurer for Calvert county shall be appointed to hold his office for the term of four years from the second Tuesday in April next, and until his successor shall be duly appointed and qualified; *Provided*, that if he shall neglect or refuse to take oath and give bond within the period of twenty days from the said second Tuesday in April next, the said office shall become vacant, and a successor shall be appointed in the manner hereinbefore provided.

The proposed amendments were severally read and adopted,

And the bill as amended,

On motion of Mr. Bond, (the rules being suspended,)

Was then read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
