AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That an Act entitled an Act to incorporate the Yearly Meeting of the Society of Friends, held on Lombard street, in the City of Baltimore, passed at January Session, 1867, chapter 108, be and the same is hereby amended by adding the following additional section thereto, to follow section 5.
