Davidge, or a majority of them, be and they are hereby authorised to raise by way of a lottery or lotteries a sum of money not exceeding thirty thousand dollars, over and above all expenses and commissions allowed on sales of tickets and in drawing said lottery or lotteries, for the purpose of purchasing a convenient lot, and erecting there-
