Sundry acts therein mentioned revived and continued to 30th October 1805, and to the end of the next session thereafter, — Acts not therein enumerated, which had expired since the (then) last session revived, and continued to 30th October 1801, &c. — All acts which would expire with that session continued in like manner, except certain acts therein mentioned. — The continuances subject to alterations which might have been made, Acts to revive, continue and make permanent, the acts of assembly therein mentioned, subject to alterations made, &c.
