Passed 8th May, 1659. An act for the Reviving and Amendment of an act, entitled, An additional act concerning the payment of Fees due from criminal Persons. Repealed by 1676, ch. 2.

## CHAP. XX.

Ditto. An act for the Payment of the public charge of this Province. Repealed by 1676, ch. 2.

## CHAP. IV.

## CHAP. V.

Ditto. An Act for the making void, and punishing of all fraudulent Practices tending to the Defraud of real Purchasers and Creditors. Lib. C and WH. fol. 188. Lib. WH. fol. 152. and Lib. WH and L. fol. 51.
