THE FOLLOWING LAWS WERE ENACTED, TO WIT:

CHAP. I.

CHAPTER I.

An Act to settle and ascertain the Salary of the Members of the Council for the ensuing year. Lib. JG. No. 4, fol. 527. Passed Jan. 5, 1805

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That each member of the council shall be entitled to receive, for the ensuing year, the sum of two hundred pounds current money for his salary. Salary ascertained

CHAP. II.

An Act for the relief of James Gantt, an Insolvent Debtor, of Prince-George's County. Lib. JG. No. 4, fol. 527. Passed Jan. 5, 1805

CHAP. III.

An Act to authorise and empower the Levy Court of Baltimore County to assess and levy a sum of money for the purposes therein mentioned. Lib. JG. No. 4, fol. 530. Passed Jan. 5, 1805

CHAP. IV.

An Act to lay out and straighten a certain Road in Baltimore County. Lib. JG. No. 4, fol. 531. Passed Jan. 5, 1805

CHAP. V.

An Act to authorise the Levy Court of Saint-Mary's County to assess and levy a sum of money for the support and maintenance of John Tuel. Lib. JG. No. 4, fol. 532. Passed Jan. 5, 1805

WHEREAS Mary Anne Tuel, of St. Mary's county, hath set forth by her petition to the general assembly, that she is a poor widow, with several children, that one of her said children called John, hath the misfortune to be an idiot, and is now about twenty-six years old, incapable of doing any kind of labour, and requires one person constantly to attend him, and praying the levy court of the said county may be authorised to assess and levy annually a sum of money for his support; Preamble.

2. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the levy court of St. Mary's county are hereby authorised and required to levy, annually, on the assessable property of the said Levy authorised for his support.
