Att which day (to witt) the 26th day of September Annoque Domini 1699 here came as well the Said Thomas Tany and uxor as the Said James Moor [499] And the Said Thomas Taney and uxor by their attorny aforesaid Prayeth that that the Said James Moor to their Declaration aforesaid might answer.

And the Said James Moore by John Maryton his Attorney comes and defends the force and Injury when etc. and Sayth that he did not assume in manner and forme and puts himselfe upon the Court. Meryton.

And the Plaintiff allso. Joshua Cecell.

Whereupon the Court haveing read and Fully understood the alligations of the Parties on both Sides and the Wittnesses on both Sides being fully heard by the Assent of the Parties aforesaid etc.

Therefore it is Considered by the Court that the afforesaid Thomas Taney and Jane his wife recover against the Said James Moore Defendant as well the Sume of five hundred and Eighteen pounds of Tobacco their Debt aforesaid as allso the Sume of two hundred Eighty two pounds of Tobacco Costs of Suite to the Said Plantives of their assent by the Court here adjudged and that the Said James Moor be in Mercy.
