Therefore it is Considered by the Court that the Afforesaid Kathrine Willson and Joshua Cecell Executors of the Last will and testament of Jonathan Willson Deceased recover against the Said Elisha Sedgewick Executor of the Last will and Testament of Robert Brothers Deceased as well the Sume of two Thousand Two hundred Seventy and three pounds of Tobacco their Debt aforesaid as also the Sume of four hundred twenty four pounds of Tobacco for their Cost and Charges of Suite to the Said Plantives of their assent by the Court here adjudged out of the Goods and Chattles whereof Robert Brothers att the time of his Death in the hands of the Said Elisha Sedgewick, if he hath Soe much thereof in his hands And the Said Elisha Sedgewick in Mercy.
