Minutes of 1944.

We the undersigned, Electors of President and Vice President of the United States of America for the respective terms beginning on the Twentieth Day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand, nine hundred and forty-five, being electors legally and duly appointed and qualified by and for the State of Maryland, as appears by the annexed Certificate made and delivered to us by the Executive of the State, having met and convened agreeably to the provision of Law at Annapolis in said State of Maryland on the Monday after the second Wednesday in December in the year of our Lord, one thousand, nine hundred and forty four.

Do hereby Certify That being so assembled and duly organized we proceeded to vote by ballot and balloted first for President and then for Vice President.

And we further Certify That the following are two distinct lists, one of the votes for President, and the other of the votes for Vice President.

As cast as aforesaid:

List of all persons voted upon for President: 8 votes.
Franklin D. Roosevelt.

List of all persons voted upon for Vice President:

Harry S. Truman - 8 votes.
