

LAWS OF MARYLAND.

WHEREAS, Said recognizance bond afterward, to wit, on the twenty-fourth day of April, 1903, was forfeited, and the penalty of said bond paid by said Lewis M. Milbourne, surety, to the sheriff of Somerset County, through the hands of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for said county; and

WHEREAS, Afterwards the said Hamson Bundick was arrested and indicted on said charge, and was, on the fourteenth day of October, 1903, tried before the Circuit Court for said Somerset County, found guilty and sentenced to be confined in the Maryland penitentiary for one year; therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That on the warrant of the Comptroller, the Treasurer of the State be and he is hereby directed to pay to the said Lewis M. Milbourne the sum of twenty-three dollars and twenty-five cents, being the amount paid by said Milbourne to the sheriff of Somerset County, through the hands of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for said county, on the twenty-fourth day of April, 1903, as bail for said Hamson Bundick.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

 CHAPTER 596.

AN ACT to lay out and establish a new election district in Frederick County out of portions of Woodsborough District, or Election District No. 11, and Mount Pleasant District, or Election District No. 13, to be called Walkersville District, or Election District No. —.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new election district be laid out and established out of portions of Woodsborough District, or Election District No. 11, and Mount Pleasant District, or Election District No. 13, of Frederick County; the said new election district to be known and called by the name of Walkersville District, or Election District No. —, of said Frederick County.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the boundaries of said Walkersville District, or Election District No. —, shall be as follows: Beginning at a point on the Monocacy river, in Woodsborough District, or Election District No. 11, now
