

49. To the Peninsula General Hospital of Salisbury, Maryland, the sum of five thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of five thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1906. Peninsula General Hospital.

50. To the United Charities Hospital Association of Dorchester County, Maryland, the sum of six thousand dollars for maintenance for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of six thousand dollars for maintenance for the fiscal year 1906. United Charities Hospital of Dorchester County.

51. To the St. Joseph's Hospital, Baltimore, Maryland, in charge of the Third Order of St. Francis of Baltimore City, the sum of five thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of five thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1906; provided, that the said hospital shall furnish one bed, maintenance and treatment for one patient at a time for each Senatorial district of the State. St. Joseph's Hospital.

52. To the Franklin Square Hospital of Baltimore City, the sum of three thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of three thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1906, upon the condition that the said hospital receive from each county in the State and from each legislative district of Baltimore City one free patient at a time each year upon the certificates of the County Commissioners of each county and the Board of Health of Baltimore City, and the further sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1905 to aid said hospital in its equipments and furnishings. 53. To Charlotte Hall School, in St. Mary's County, the sum of five thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of five thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1906; said moneys to be used in accordance with Chapter 321 of the Acts of 1898. Charlotte Hall School.

54. To St. Joseph's House of Industry, the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1906. St. Joseph's House of Industry.

55. To the Home of the Aged of Talbot County, the sum of thirty-five hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of thirty-five hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1906. Home of the Aged of Talbot County.

56. To the Johns Hopkins University, the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of twenty-five thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1906.

57. To the Hebrew Aged Home of Baltimore City, the sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1906. Hebrew Aged Home.
