

## LAWS OF MARYLAND.

## CHAPTER 426.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the Board of Public Works of Maryland to collect the insurance upon State Tobacco Warehouses Nos. 1 and 2, and place the same to the credit of the Tobacco Warehouse Fund, and to either rebuild a modern warehouse on the present site of Tobacco Warehouses Nos. 1 and 2, and the property owned by the State adjacent thereto, or to sell said property or lease the same for such sum as they may think right and build a tobacco warehouse in some other locality of Baltimore City selected by said Board of Public Works.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Board of Public Works of the State of Maryland be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to collect the insurance now due upon State Tobacco Warehouses Nos. 1 and 2, and pay the same to the Treasurer of the State of Maryland, who is hereby authorized and directed to place the same to the State Tobacco Warehouse Fund.

Empowered to collect insurance on State buildings.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That said Board of Public Works be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to either rebuild the said warehouses upon their present site or to build one large warehouse upon said property or upon the property owned by the State adjacent thereto, or to sell the said property above mentioned for such price as to them seems proper, or lease the same on such terms and conditions and for such rental as to them seems proper, and purchase or lease suitable property in some other section of Baltimore City and build said tobacco warehouse upon the same; provided, however, in either event that the said Board of Public Works shall build a warehouse or warehouses with a capacity for storing at least fifteen thousand hogsheads of tobacco.

Authority to rebuild or sell the site.

Proviso.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted.* That all moneys received by the said Board of Public Works for insurance, and all money received for the sale or lease of the property above mentioned for the same so to be sold or leased shall be placed by the Treasurer of the State of Maryland to the credit of the State Tobacco Warehouse Fund; and all moneys used in rebuilding said warehouse or procuring a new site therefor shall be taken from said fund.

State Tobacco Warehouse Fund.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
