Sec. 4. *And be it enacted*, That in case of refusal, death, resignation or disqualification of the Mayor, or any Councilman, a new election shall be made by a majority of said Councilmen to supply such vacancy. Vacancies

Sec. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the town of Cumberland shall be and is hereby erected, constituted and made an incorporated town, and that the corporate body of the said town consist of a Mayor and six Councilmen, which said Mayor and Councilmen shall be a body corporate and one community forever, in right and by the name of the Mayor and Councilmen of the town of Cumberland, and shall be able to sue and be sued at law, and to act and to execute, do and perform as a body corporate, which shall have succession forever, and to that end to have a common seal and the same to change and alter at pleasure. Sec. 6. *And be it enacted*, That the limits of the said town for all purposes, except taxation by the laws of the corporation, shall be as follows: half a mile in every direction all round the town, to be computed and measured from the town lots on the outer edge or confines of the town proper, as located and settled by law, and by the plat already recorded among the records of Allegany county. CHAPTER 176

A supplement to the act, entitled, an act for opening and increasing the width of German Lane, in the city of Baltimore, passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty one, chap. three hundred and one. Passed Mar. 11, 1834

SECTION I. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Solomon Etting, Joseph Cushing, Benjamin D. Higdon, Samuel Moore, and James Carroll, junior, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners in lieu of the persons appointed by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, under and by virtue of the act to which this is a supplement, and they or a majority of them, are Commissioners named to supersede &c
