Passed Jan. 10, 1834 Resolution granting indulgence to Isaac G. Magruder, Collector of Prince George's county.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Isaac G. Magruder, collector of Prince George's county, have until the first day of March next to collect and pay into the treasury, five hundred and twelve dollars and sixty-six cents, being the quota of said county to the colonization fund for the year eighteen hundred and thirty-three.*

Passed Jan. 11. Resolution authorising the Armourer to deliver to Captain Alexander Cheves, arms, &c.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Armourer at Annapolis be and he is hereby required to deliver to Captain Alexander Cheves, of Baltimore city, any arms or accoutrements not exceeding seventy five of each, which the said Cheves may select, on his giving such security for the safe keeping and return of the same as the Governor and Council may require.*
