Resolution in favor of Elie Dale, for the use of Marshal Passed Feb. 19, 1834

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the Eastern shore, pay to Elié Dale, for the use of Marshall Smith, of Worcester county, the sum of twenty seven dollars and eighty cents, the same being the amount of composition money paid by the afore-said Marshall Smith, for a tract of land called Hardluck, which said tract of land was patented to a certain Littleton Truit, at a prior date.
