Said bill was then sent to the Senate.

The bill entitled an Act to authorize citizens of Talbot and Dorchester counties to take or catch oysters with scoop or scrape, in the waters of the Choptank River,

Being upon a third reading,

Mr. Johnson, (the rules being suspended by unanimous consent,) submitted the following amendment :

Section 1, line 9, strike out the words "first day of October," and insert "fifteenth day of September."

The proposed amendment was adopted.

Mr. Johnson submitted the following amendment :

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Add new section, to be section 8:

SECTION 8. *And be it enacted,* That nothing in this Act shall be construed so as to prevent the residents of Dorchester county, who have been licensed to catch oysters in the waters of Fishing Bay and Hongo River with scrape, from enjoying the privileges of this Act.

The proposed amendment was adopted.

The bill, as amended, was then read a third time and passed by yeas and nays, as follows :
