Being on second reading,

Mr. Steiner submitted the following amendment:

Page 2, line 4, insert after the word "deceased" the words "not exceeding three hundred dollars."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Earle moved to reconsider the vote by which said amendment was adopted.

Which was determined in the affirmative.
