CHAPTER 120.

AN ACT to appropriate the sum of money to pay David Grogg, late collector of State Taxes in the eight district of Carroll county, the amount over-paid by him into the Treasury.

Appropriation to David Grogg      SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller of this State, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer of this State, to pay to David Grogg of Carroll county, the sum of thirty-one dollars and thirty-six cents, being the amount over-paid by said David Grogg into the Treasury, as collector of State taxes for the eight district of Carroll county, as certified to by the Comptroller of this State.

In force.      SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
