

for any one year, which tax shall be collected by a collector appointed for that purpose, and paid over to the president and board of commissioners.

SEC. 12. *And be it enacted*, That the collector by them appointed, shall give bond in the sum of six hundred dollars, for the faithful performance of his duty; he shall be vested with the same authority for the collection of town taxes, as the several county collectors are now by law vested; and the commissioners shall fix the term of office, responsibility and compensation of said collector.

Give bond.

SEC. 13. *And be it enacted*, That the commissioners shall not expend nor contract to expend in any one year, more money than the amount receivable from taxes and other sources for that year.

SEC. 14. *And be it enacted*, That the said commissioners or a majority of them, shall have power and authority annually, to appoint a bailiff, whose duty it shall be to preserve the peace and good order of said town, and for this purpose he is hereby invested with the same powers and authority as any constable may now have under the laws of this State: he shall give bond for the faithful performance of his duty, and shall receive for his services the sum of forty dollars per annum.

SEC. 15. *And be it enacted*, That the said commissioners shall have power, and are hereby authorized to straighten and widen streets, open new streets, make foot-ways, or side-walks, construct bridges, purchase stone, timber, as they may deem essential to the comfort, convenience and prosperity of said town of Vienna, and also to purchase or condemn a lot of land adjacent to said town, for the purpose of procuring dirt for the use of the streets and side-walks, and after having given at least ten days' notice in writing to all persons interested, they shall appoint a committee of three discreet persons, not residents of said town, who shall under a penalty of ten dollars, proceed to assess and value on oath what damages may have been sustained by reason of such widening, opening or straightning of said streets, or of the condemnation of said lot, and shall make return thereof to said commissioners, under their hands
