

- No. 344. An act supplementary to an act passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter one hundred and sixty-eight, entitled an additional supplement to an act to incorporate the Roman Catholic Congregation in Baltimore town, passed November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-five, chapter fifteen, to enable the said corporation to purchase a new burial ground..... 506
- No. 346. An act to authorize the County Commissioners of Garrett county, to borrow money on the credit of the county for the purpose of erecting a court-house and county jail, to issue bonds for the payment of the same, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of the county, to redeem said bonds and to pay the interest thereon..... 508

An act to amend the charter of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company, and to repeal so much of the act passed March twenty-second, eighteen hundred and thirty-three, entitled an act to provide for the continuation of the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road to Harper's Ferry, and for other purposes, as prohibits the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company from selling or disposing of any of the surplus water of said canal, to be applied any where within this State to the manufacture of any species or description of grain.... 511
