Amend title so as to read

A bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower Isaac Reroner, Samuel D. Fox and William H. Martz, Trustees of a school house in school district No. 104, Frederick county, to sell and dispose of the said school house in said district.

Amend section 1, line 2, by striking out all after word "Maryland," and inserting the following: "That Isaac Reroner, Samuel D. Fox and William H. Martz, Trustees of a school house, known as Oak Hill School House, in school district No. 104, of Frederick county, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to sell at public or private sale, the said school house, in said district, for cash or on such terms as they may determine, to the highest bidder, and to convey the same and divide the proceeds *pro rata* amongst
