

faithful discharge of their duties as commissioners, which said bonds shall be lodged with the clerks of the county courts of each of said counties, and may be sued as any public bonds now are, and a certified copy of said bonds, under the seal of either of the county court clerks aforesaid, shall be evidence in any court of law or equity in this state.

CHAP. 107.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That in case of the death or Vacancies. refusal to act of any of the commissioners herein named, the commissioner who shall have been appointed to act with him, may appoint some other person, resident of the county in which he was a commissioner, to act in his place, and the person so appointed, shall have the same powers and authorities as are vested in the said commissioners by this act.

Sec. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall render to the commissioners made of monies laid out. the completion of said bridge, a true, full and fair account, of all monies by them laid out and expended by virtue of this act, in building and completing said bridge, and the said commissioners in the respective counties, shall make such compensation to said commissioners as they in their judgment shall think proper.

CHAPTER 107.

*An Act for the relief of Susanna Holmes, of Balti- Passed Feb 17
more County.*

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Divorce. Maryland*, That Susanna Holmes, of Baltimore county, be and she is hereby divorced from bed, board, and mutual cohabitation, with her husband, William S. Holmes.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said William S. Claims annul- Holmes shall not, by virtue of his marriage with the said ed. Susanna Holmes, be authorised to have or claim any right or interest in the estate, real, personal or mixed, of the said Susanna Holmes, whether acquired in any manner whatever, before or after the passage of this act; nor shall Susanna Holmes be authorised to have or claim any right or interest in the estate, real, personal or mixed, of the said William S Holmes, whether acquired in any manner whatever, before or after the passage of this act.
