*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the treasurer of the western shore pay to Mary Benson, widow of General Perry Benson, or order, during her widowhood, in quarter-yearly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a captain, in consideration for the services of her late husband during the revolutionary war.

A Resolution in favour of James Maxwell, of Washington County. Passed Feb 24

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the treasurer of the western shore be, and he is hereby authorised and required, to pay to David Brookhart, Esquire, for the use of James Maxwell, of Hagerstown, five dollars, as a compensation for furnishing, under orders of the house of delegates, his newspaper to certain members of the general assembly, in the session of eighteen hundred and twenty-eight, eighteen hundred and twenty-nine, and eighteen hundred and thirty.
