Of Montgomery county, authorised to levy a sum of money for the use of James N Allnut

Of Saint-Mary's county, to meet and appoint a clerk, who shall enter into bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars, &c. to cause their clerk to deliver an alphabetical list of the persons chargeable with the assessment, to the collector, and to receive such compensation for his services as the said court may direct, not exceeding one hundred dollars

Of Calvert county abolished, and their powers and duties vested in and transferred to the commissioners of the county

25 28

Of Charles county, authorised to accept a bridge over the main stream of Zachia Swamp, and in their discretion to allow to George Gardiner, and William Mudd, such sum as in their estimation may be just and equitable, to be levied and collected as other county charges

30 31

Of Caroline county, empowered to levy a sum of money not exceeding one hundred dollars, to build a bridge and causeway over Old town Branch, &c.

The annual meeting of the levy court of Prince-George's county which is now required to be held between the fifteenth and twenty-fifth day of January, to be hereafter held for the purposes of said
