

CHAP. 144. **SEC. 3.** *And be it enacted,* That from and after the passage of this act, the officers of the Elk Ridge Landing Lyceum, shall consist of a President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Librarian and five Managers, who shall be elected by ballot, on the first Tuesday in January next, and annually thereafter, a majority of members present at the meeting being necessary to constitute a choice; the association shall also have power to appoint such other officers as they may deem necessary and expedient, in such manner as they may think proper.

Existing regulations and officers

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That until there shall be under this act, an election of officers necessary to the uses of this institution, those now acting or who may be hereafter appointed to act under any existing regulations of the association, shall continue so to do according to the provisions of the association heretofore made, and such regulations shall till lawfully altered be deemed as valid and obligatory as if made since the passage of this act.

Individual liabilities

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted,* That no member of this institution shall in his individual capacity be answerable for any losses, deficiencies or failures of the joint fund or debt, of the said society, nor for any more or larger sum or sums of money whatever, then the current amount by him payable into the common fund of the society.
