

CHAP. 294.

George Gale, a deed therefor, conveying the said lands with others to Henry A. Hall, of Anne Arundel county, a security, on whose credit he had raised the money to pay for the said land, which deed is duly recorded in Liber W. S. G., number twenty, one of the land record books of Anne Arundel county, folios number one hundred and fifty-five, one hundred and fifty-six, and one hundred and fifty-seven, and that some doubts are entertained, whether said lands are not liable to escheat, since the death of Jonathan Neale Laughlin, the former proprietor :—Therefore,

Release

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That all the right, title, interest and estate, which the State of Maryland now has or may hereafter have in and to the said tracts of land, be and the same are hereby released, granted and confirmed to the said Martin Fenwick, his heirs and assigns forever.

CHAPTER 293.

Passed Mar. 24, 1836 *An act to divorce Eliza Chavalier, of the City of Baltimore, from her husband Nicholas W. Chavalier.*

Divorce

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the marriage heretofore solemnized between Eliza Chavalier of the City of Baltimore, and Nicholas W. Chavalier, her husband, be, and the same is hereby declared null and void, and that the said Eliza Chavalier and Nicholas W. Chavalier, be, and they are hereby divorced a vinculo matrimonii.

Guardianship

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That said Eliza Chavalier, be, and she is hereby declared to be entitled to the guardianship of her child or children by her marriage with said Chavalier.
