CHAPTER 332.

Passed April 2, 1836 *A further additional supplement to an act, entitled, an act for quieting possessions, enrolling conveyances, and securing the estates of purchasers.*

Deeds not conforming act of 1831 made valid

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That all deeds or instruments of writing which have been taken, executed and acknowledged within this State, since the tenth day of February, eighteen hundred and thirty-four, which may not have been certified by the takers of the acknowledgments of said deeds or instruments of writing, as required by the act of December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-one, chapter two hundred and five, be, and are hereby confirmed and made valid, to all intents and purposes; *Provided,* that in other respects the said deeds or instruments of writing have been executed, acknowledged, and recorded in conformity with the laws relating to the subject at that time in force in this State.
