We herewith submit a report of cases heard and decisions rendered by the State Appeal Board under the Alcoholic Beverages Law for the fiscal year beginning July 1st, 1950 and ending June 30th, 1951.

In Charles, Queen Anne's, Somerset and Worcester Counties, the Board acts as hearing officers, their decision being subject to appeal to the Circuit Courts of these counties. One appeal was taken from the decision of this Board to the Circuit Court of Charles County, and one appeal to the Circuit Court of Somerset County.
