

5. To the bequest as contained in the last will and testament of Susan Asenath Harwood, late of Baltimore City, of \$1,000.00 to the Vestry of All Saints Parish, in Calvert county.

6. To the devise contained in the twenty-first item of the last will and testament of Levin S.
